


Stoke-on-Trent City

- Made up of 6 towns
 This is so important to the locals but no one out of the area knows this!
- Hanley being the city centre. The original 'Stoke upon Trent' town, is only a small part of the city and the most deprived.







Methods

We designed and created an online questionnaire, making it easy for people to fill in, save and email back.

These were also given out as hardcopies to be filled in and returned.







Our target group

- A cross section from both within the 'City' and outside of the 'City'
- 18 year olds to retirement age
- Professionals from service industries to education







Respondents

- 60% were people within the city of Stoke on Trent
- 40% were outside of the area
 Mainly from the surrounding areas but also from Scotland and abroad

Outside the city


- Female **37.50**%

Recommendations

- Investment and correct allocation of the city's budget
- Developing brown field sites
- Creating new jobs
- Improving community services
- Look at creating new tourist areas
 Heritage is important but will need a revamp in thinking to attract new people here
